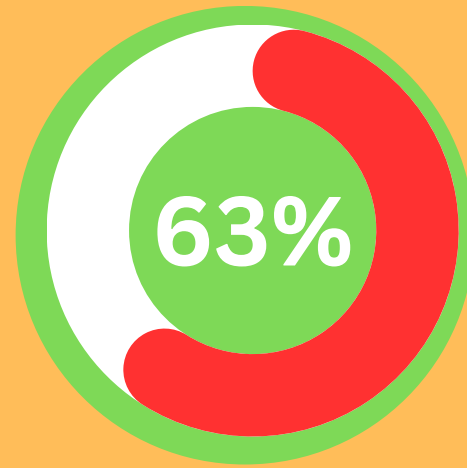
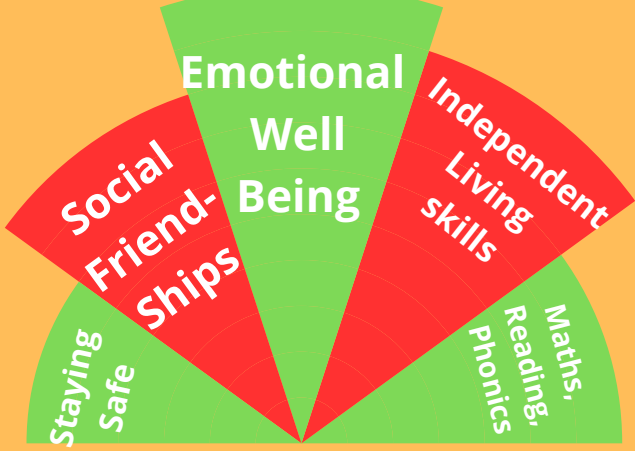

63% of parents and carers would prefer to attend parental engagement in person.

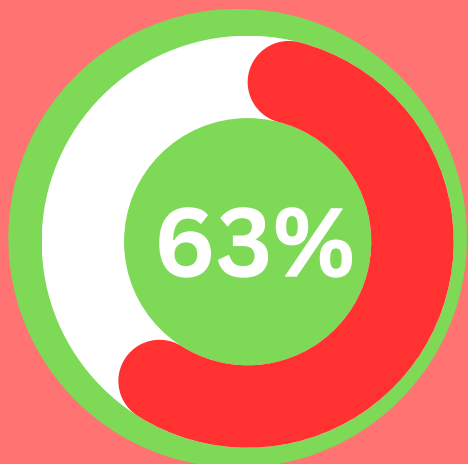
What has been helpful?

What could we improve on?

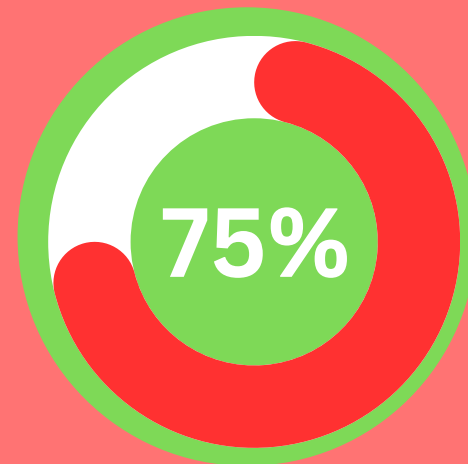
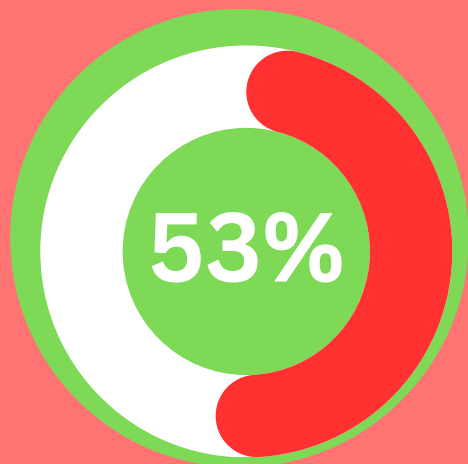
- Termly class get together so parents can get to know other parents in the child's class.

53% of parents and carers feel Oak Tree help them to be involved in their child's learning and progress.

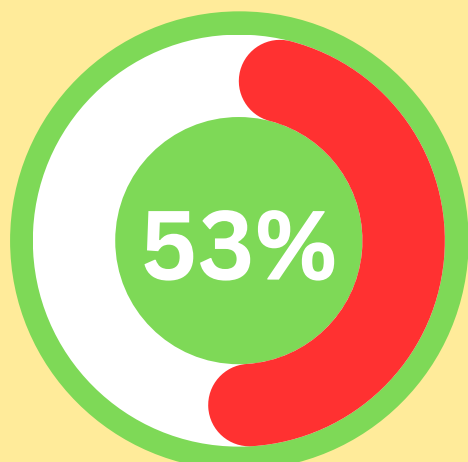


75% of parents and carers either strongly agree or agree they know what is expected in terms of home learning.

Preferred method of home learning.

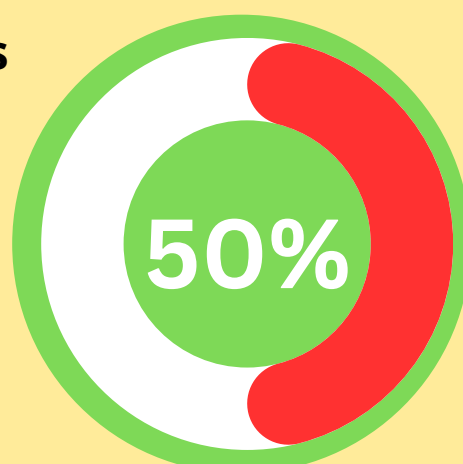
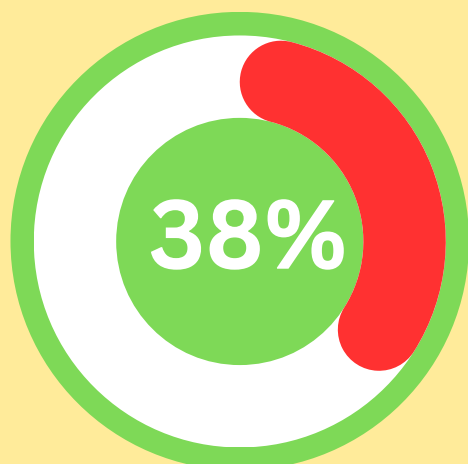
Parents and carers commented they would like home learning to be available via home packs, homework grids or available through the OTS website.

Transitions



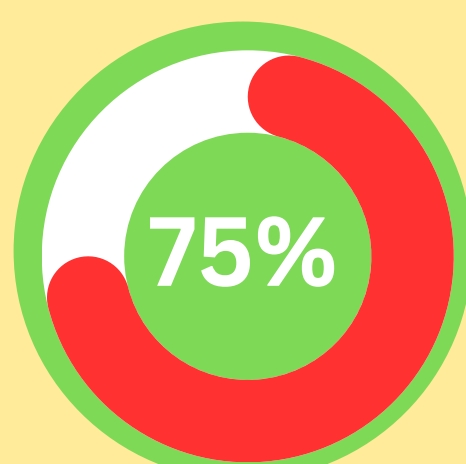
53% of parents and carers either strongly agree or agree 'in school' class transition is well communicated.

75% of parents and carers either agree or feel neutral about what happens when their child leaves Oak Tree.



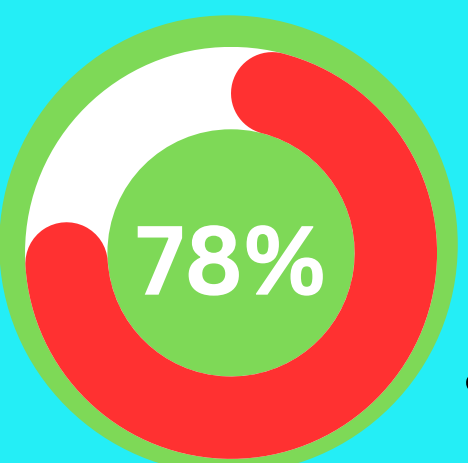
38% of parents and carers agree Oak Tree staff prepare their child for leaving at 16.

100% of parents and carers strongly agree the school is welcoming on the phone.

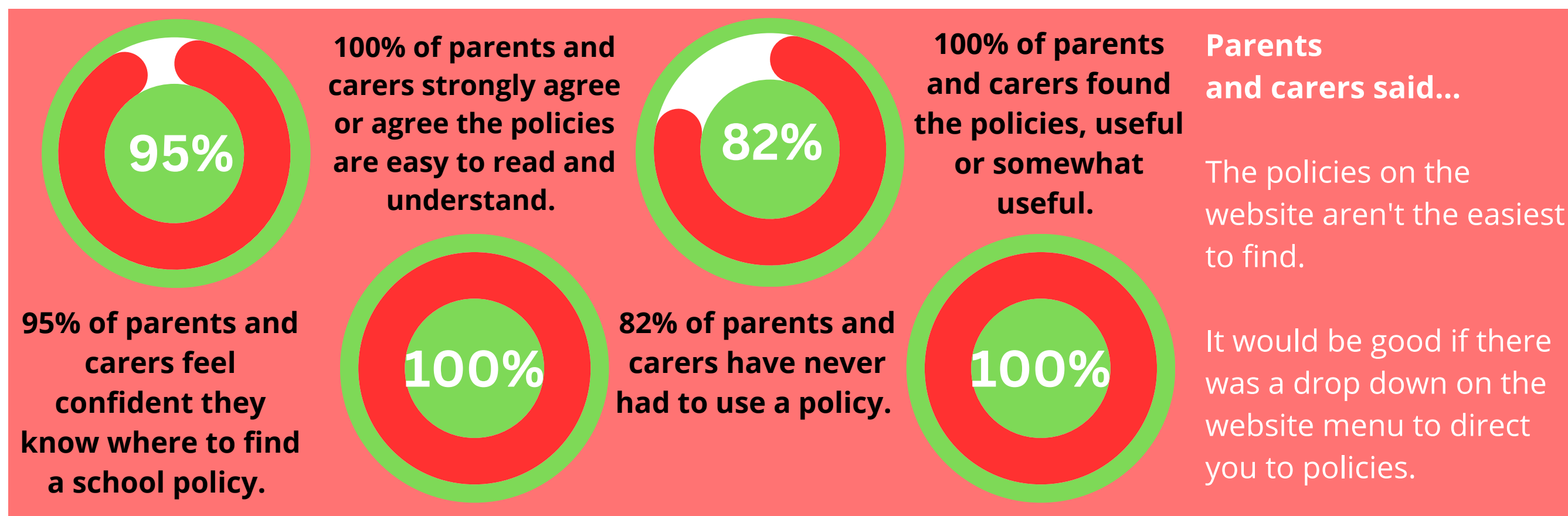

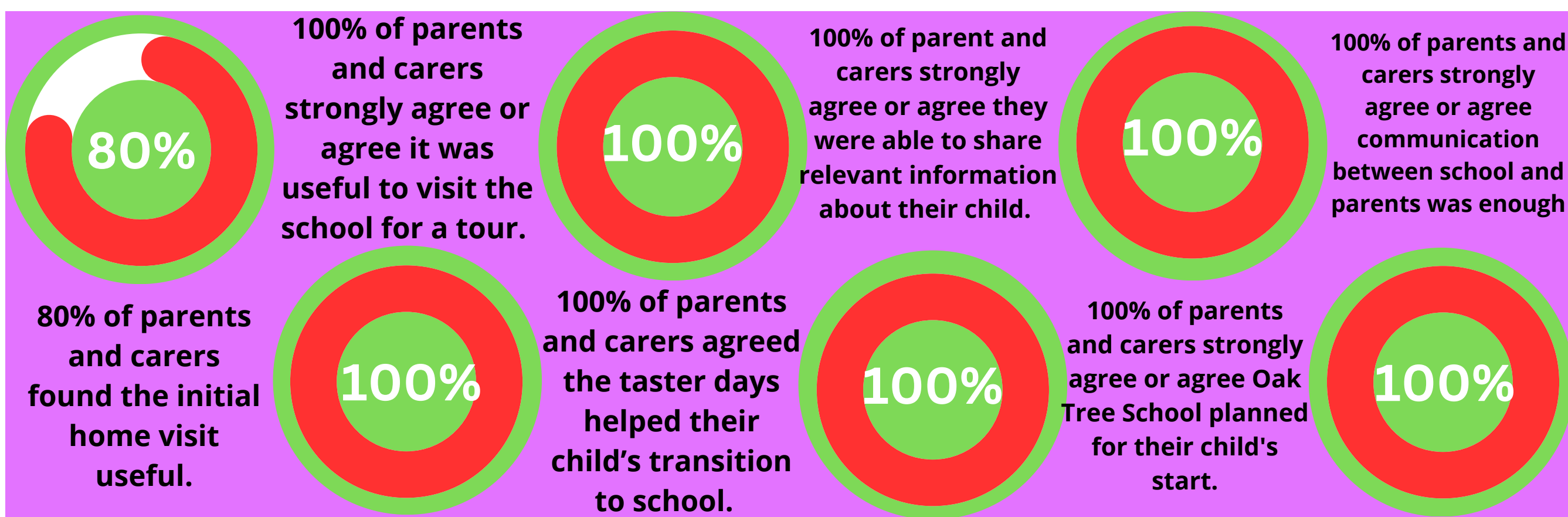

Improvements made

Oak Tree School have implemented a new home school communication system to ensure parents get all the information they need by email.

A new calendar of parent and carer workshops and events have been compiled for this academic year.

More opportunities on offer for parents and carers to be involved in whole school activities, sporting fixtures, cultural events, book fair and enjoying reading with their children.

More regular parental engagement weeks being offered throughout the school year.

Improvements made to the website to make it more user friendly for parent and carers.

Our first ever Post 16 transition event and Options evening took place in May, last year, inviting parents and carers to meet with staff and further education provisions.

In progress

Various apps are currently being piloted and explored as another form of home school communication which will provide daily updates, curriculum information, events specific to your child's class.

Programme of events/curriculum workshops for joint learning for students with their parents or carers is being explored for the new academic year.

Parents and Carers Workshops calendar of events designed for 23/24 to include topics requested in recent feedback from parents/carers.

Homework grids to be provided for all classes and linked to the school website. The opportunity for all students to engage in home learning should they choose to.

Access to webinars on the school website for parents and carers to support their children's learning in specialist subjects e.g. English and Maths.
